Participants in “DERBY ROW” provide 500 “samplings” of food reflecting Kentucky Derby fare and to dress their space with a Derby theme. Whether you serve Derby favorites like Kentucky Hot Browns, bourbon-marinated pork tenderloin, country ham and biscuits, chocolate-bourbon pecan pie and bourbon balls, shrimp skewers or put a Derby twist on a best-selling menu item, your inspired space on Derby Row will draw in guests. Your samples, should be generous but do not have to be full meals. Last year, guests sampled small taster cups of she-crab soup, mini pizza squares, mini salads, garlic knots, bites of braised beef and more.

There are two opportunities to win: 1) You will be judged by a jury of your peers on your station and the food served, and 2) as a crowd favorite. Winners receive recognition and awards at the event. All participants will have signage at the event, be mentioned in the Event Program and mentioned on our website at www.setonyouthshelters.org, on our Facebook page, and in our newsletter following the event.

Each Derby Row station must be totally self-contained. We provide the tent space and tables: You are responsible for set-up, staffing and take-down, and everything required for food prep, service and compliance with health code requirements. Please review the guidelines that follow and fill out your Entry Form completely. The number of participants is limited, so please submit your registration early to guarantee your space and inclusion in printed materials. Due to Health Department regulations, no cooking on site is permitted.

Seton Youth Shelters’ Kentucky Derby Celebration is getting a facelift and you can play a pivotal role in making this annual event the “go to” party of the year - with a purpose.
